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The Pig Personality Profile

Instructions

1. On a blank piece of paper, draw a pig.
2. Do not look at your neighbor's pig.
3. Do not even glance.

Analysis

1. If your pig:
 - a) is toward the top of the paper, you are a positive, optimistic person.
 - b) is toward the middle of the paper (top to bottom), you are a realist.
 - c) is toward the bottom of the paper, you are pessimistic and have a tendency to behave negatively.
 - d) is facing left, you believe in tradition, are friendly, and remember dates, including birthdays.
 - e) is facing forward (looking at you) you are direct, enjoy playing the devil's advocate, and neither fear nor avoid discussions.
 - f) is facing right, you are innovative and active, but don't have a strong sense of family, nor do you remember dates.
 - g) was drawn with many details, you are analytical, cautious, and distrustful.
 - h) was drawn with few details, you are emotional and naïve; you care little for details and are a risk-taker.
 - i) was drawn with four legs showing, you are secure, stubborn, and stick with your ideas.
 - j) was drawn with less than four legs showing, you are insecure, or are living through a period of major change.
2. The size of the pig's ears indicate how good a listener the artist is - large is good.
3. The length of the pig's tail indicates the quality of the artist's love life - more is better.
